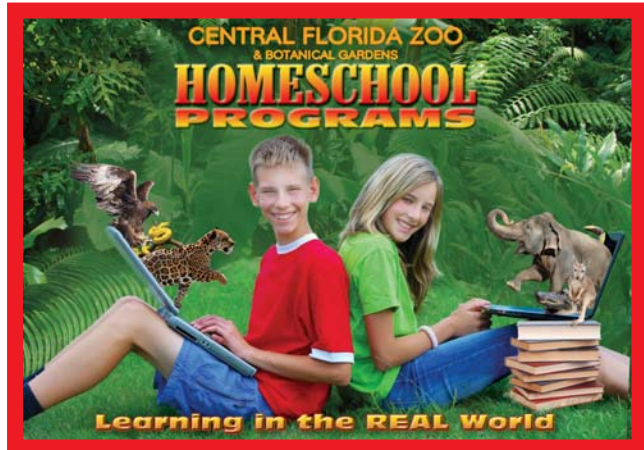

This exciting three part series will take students on an amazing journey as we investigate just what it takes to be a bird.
