

Laws of the Jungle

- » Cameras, including GoPros and cell phones, etc., are not allowed over any habitat barriers.
- » Selfie sticks are not permitted in the Zoo.
- » For the health of our animals and guests, smoking/vaping is not permitted in the Zoo.
- » Our animals are on special diets. **PLEASE DO NOT FEED THE ANIMALS.**
- » Outside food or coolers, radios, frisbees, roller skates, skateboards, or skateshoes are not permitted in the Zoo.
- » Please do not throw objects; it is hazardous to our guests and animals.
- » For your protection, please do not climb or sit children on railings or fences.
- » Shirts and shoes must be worn.
- » Only service animals are allowed in the Zoo. Pets are not allowed in the Zoo.
- » No outside alcoholic beverages allowed on Zoo property.
- » All photos taken at the Zoo by our guests are prohibited from commercial use.
- » Your photo may be taken during your visit for use in promotions. If you wish to decline, please notify a staff member.
