### Birdwatching Binoculars

#### Supplies:

- Toilet paper rolls (x2)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Yarn or string
- Markers, crayons, or paint
- Leaves, twigs, or grass clippings
- Hole puncher



#### Instructions:

1. Decorate the outside of your toilet paper rolls with any design you would like.
2. Attach your toilet paper rolls together. This can be done using tape, glue, or by wrapping string around the outside of the tubes.



3. Cut a piece of string long enough to be worn around your neck like

a necklace.

4. Punch a hole on each side at the end of your binoculars and tie the string to the binoculars.
5. Glue your leaves and twigs onto your binoculars.
6. Go outside and see how many birds you can find. Use the provided Florida Bird ID Guide to see if you can identify the birds you find.
