# **Birdwatching Binoculars**

# **Supplies:**

- Toilet paper rolls (x2)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Yarn or string
- Markers, crayons, or paint
- Leaves, twigs, or grass clippings
- · Hole puncher



#### **Instructions:**

- Decorate the outside of your toilet paper rolls with any design you would like.
- Attach your toilet paper rolls together. This can be done using tape, glue, or by wrapping string around the outside of the tubes.



3. Cut a piece of string long enough to be worn around your neck like



a necklace.

- 4. Punch a hole on each side at the end of your binoculars and tie the string to the binoculars.
- 5. Glue your leaves and twigs onto your binoculars.
- 6. Go outside and see how many birds you can find. Use the provided Florida Bird ID Guide to see if you can identify the birds you find.
