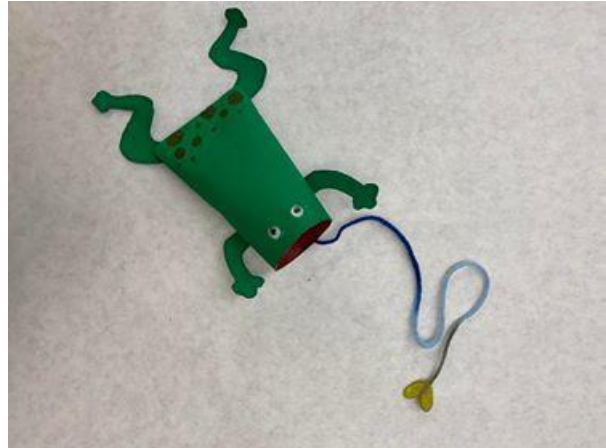
## Wild Crafts from the Central Florida Zoo & Botanical Gardens

### Frog Fly Catcher

#### Supplies:

- Toilet paper rolls (x2)
- Glue or tape
- Scissors
- Yarn or string
- Markers, crayons, or paint
- Googly eyes
- Stapler



#### Instructions:

1. Decorate the outside of one of your toilet paper rolls with any design you would like. We painted ours green on the outside and red on the inside.
2. Cut your other roll down one side and flatten it into a square. On this roll, draw the legs and fly. Cut these shapes out and decorate them.
3. Staple together one end of your decorated toilet paper roll.
4. Glue or tape the legs and eyes onto your frog. If you don't have googly eyes you can draw or paint them on.
5. Cut a piece of yarn about 12 inches long. Attach one end of your string to the frog and one end to the fly using tape or glue.
6. Enjoy trying to catch the fly in your frog's mouth.
