Frog Fly Catcher

Supplies:

- Toilet paper rolls (x2)
- Glue or tape
- Scissors
- Yarn or string
- Markers, crayons, or paint
- Googly eyes
- Stapler



Instructions:

- 1. Decorate the outside of one of your toilet paper rolls with any design you would like. We painted ours green on the outside and red on the inside.
- 2. Cut your other roll down one side and flatten it into a square. On this roll, draw the legs and fly. Cut these shapes out and decorate them.
- 3. Staple together one end of your decorated toilet paper roll.
- 4. Glue or tape the legs and eyes onto your frog. If you don't have googly eyes you can draw or paint them on.
- 5. Cut a piece of yarn about 12 inches long. Attach one end of your string to the frog and one end to the fly using tape or glue.
- 6. Enjoy trying to catch the fly in your frog's mouth.
