Make an Alligator


Supplies:

- Toilet paper tubes (x2)
- Scissors
- Paint or markers
- Glue or tape
- Googly eyes (optional)



Instructions:

- 1. Draw the outline of your alligator on your toilet paper tubes.
 - a. On the first tube, draw rows of teeth on one end and two connected rectangles on the underside. These will be the front legs.
 - b. On the second tube, draw two more rectangles on the underside for the hind legs.
 - c. Behind the rear legs, draw a square at the end of the tube. This will be cut out, so the part left will be the tail.
 - d. Draw some triangle shaped scales on the top side.





- 2. Carefully cut out the drawn-on sections.
 - a. Cut out the shape of the teeth and the square for the tail.
 - b. Cut the long ends of the rectangles for the legs and the midline connecting them, leaving the short ends attached.
 - c. Cut the scales on the topside leaving the long edge attached so they fold up.
- 3. Color and decorate your alligator.
- 4. Attach the googly eyes. If you don't have googly eyes, you can always draw eyes on.
- Secure the two ends of the alligator together. You can slide one tube into the other or attach with tape or glue.
